HIBERNIA MARCHING SOCIETY OF MISSISSIPPI, INC.

The Hibernia Marching Society was organized in Biloxi, Mississippi, in 1978 and incorporated as The Hibernia Marching Society of Mississippi, Inc., in 1989.

Although the Society was not formally organized until 1978, informal gatherings were held for about seventeen years by several spirited Irish-Americans at Mary Mahoney's Old French House Restaurant in Biloxi, Mississippi. Often the idea of organizing a St. Patrick's Day Parade was discussed, however, a wee bit of Irish Blarney tells us that the idea lasted no longer than the last bottle of Bushmill.

In 1978, Dr. John O'Keefe, a Biloxi physician, decided to take some action. He placed an article in the Sun Herald newspaper, extending an invitation to all Irish, and those who would like to be Irish, to attend a meeting at Mary Mahoney's to discuss the organization of the first St. Patrick's Day Parade and the establishment of a society to sponsor such events. From that modest beginning the Hibernia Marching Society of Mississippi, Inc. has become one of the largest and most viable organizations on the Gulf Coast offering a variety of events, most of which are described in this publication.

The purpose of the Society is to promote interest in Irish Heritage and to develop a greater appreciation for Irish Culture. Allied with these objectives is the desire to experience good fun and good fellowship among members of the Society who are Irish by birth, marriage or desire.

Grand Marshal
BILLY HEWES

Grand Marshall Billy Hewes credits his success and long run of good luck to his marriage of 24 years. 'Twas a blessed moment the day he laid eyes on that one! Forever bewitched, he was." Together, he and Paula are the proud parents of four children: two lovely lasses, and two fine lads (one may actually be a leprechaun).

Billy is serving his fifth term as a Mississippi State Senator and was unanimously elected by his peers to the position of President Pro Tempore. He has represented the Magnolia State on the national and international stage serving in various leadership capacities with civic, political, and professional organizations. Hewes is a graduate of the University of Southern Mississippi, the owner of Billy Hewes Insurance Agency, and a Broker-Associate with Billy Hewes Real Estate.

"While Hewes is more Welsh in its origin, the names Crowley, Riley, and O'Reilly dot our family genealogy tracing back to Counties Cavan and Clare. It is believed that my paternal great-great-grandparents Frank and Elizabeth (Riley) Crowley came to the United States shortly after the Civil War and settled in Michigan.

Mamoo (my great-grandmother) was born in Michigan in 1874, the only daughter of eight children. Her given name was Margaret Jeannette Crowley. She was sent to a convent school in Vicksburg which was probably run by nuns from Ireland. Her parents most likely wanted her education to be at the hands of trusted Irish folks. It was at this school that Fredrick Searle Hewes (my great-grandfather) met her while visiting the Hewes family in Tallulah, Louisiana, on what must have been the remaining land holdings of William G. Hewes who had come to New Orleans from Boston well before the Civil War. She was his junior by about 11 years, and must have absolutely captured his heart and him hers as well. This observation is based upon a stack of letters that F. S. Hewes wrote to her in a beautiful, nearly calligraphic hand. My Uncle Andy tells me that my Grandmother (Janie) Hewes would not read them after seeing how personal they were and instead left them undisturbed in Mamoo's attic. They have since been lost. In any case, she was a real Irishman and talked of many things Irish right up to her death, including the little people (leprechauns), the fairies, the coach-a-bower, and the Banshee. From the references to Ireland that my Grandfather, Judge (William G.) Hewes, made from time to time, he must have grown up with Mamoo's stories of the beauty of Ireland, its people, and its way of life.

As a Smith, my mother has indicated that her side of the family claims Irish, Scotch, and English lineage. Of course, with a unique surname like "Smith" we can likely lay claim to a number of peoples. Good stuff for an Irish politician! Paula's side of the family claims Irish ancestry through her maternal Grandmother Katie Kiernann who emigrated from Kilkenny County to New Orleans. - My thanks to Andy Hewes for providing much of this family history.

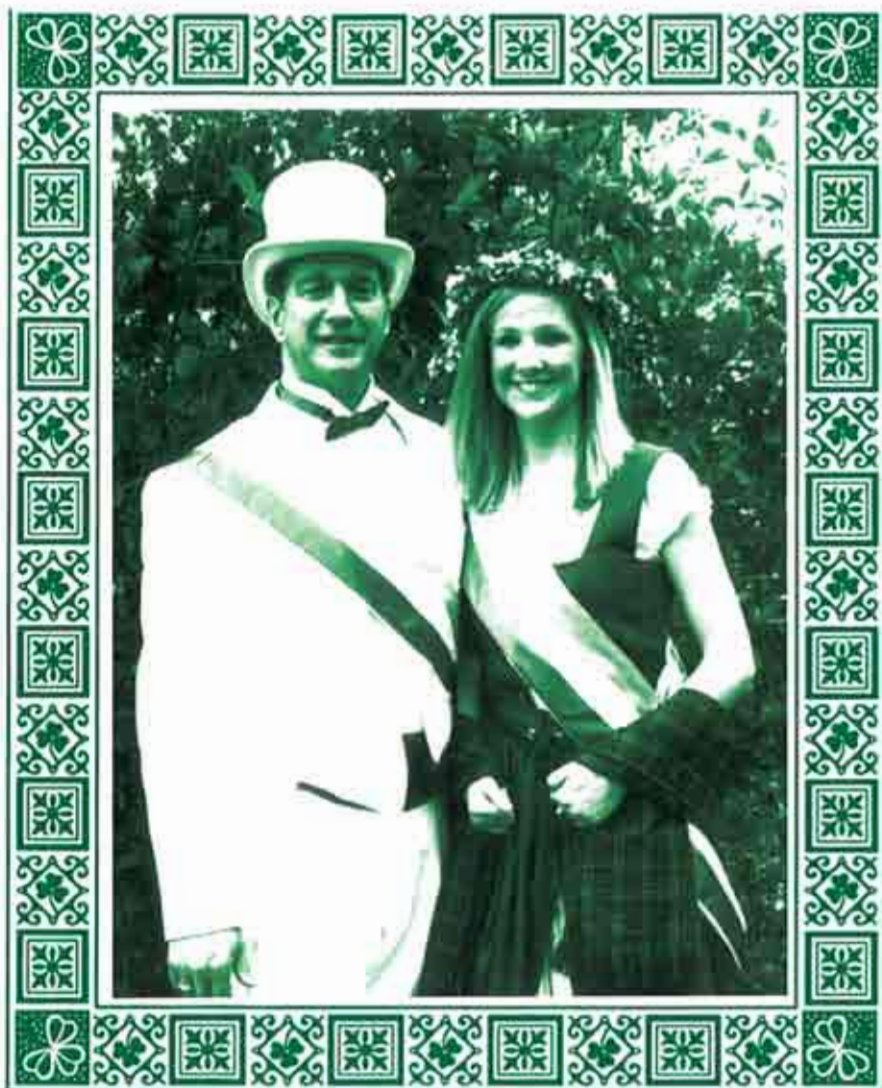

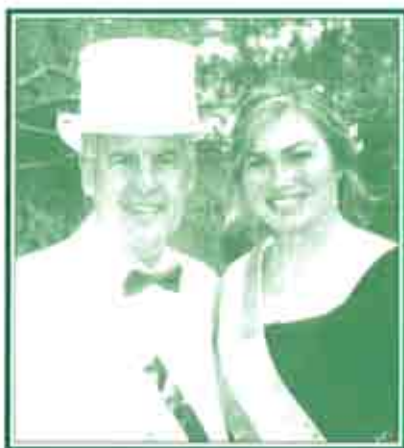

Happy St. Patrick's Day!

Centuries ago, when Britain was ruled by Rome, there was a young boy named Patrick, who lived in Britain with his family. Although Patrick's parents raised him as a Christian, he didn't take their teachings seriously. He preferred to follow the sinful ways of the other youths.

Patrick continued in this way of life until one day he was captured by a band of marauders from Ireland, who made him go as a slave back to their own country. They forced him to live in poverty, misery and hunger, working as a shepherd and a swineherd.

Patrick missed Britain and his family, so much so that he thought his heart would break. How could he have taken everything so much for granted? He began to pray, asking God to help him ... asking for forgiveness. And the Lord heard his prayer, filling him with the fire of a new faith he had never known before. He was completely transformed.

One night, while Patrick was still in captivity, God showed him a way to escape from Ireland, and, after six years of slavery, he found his way back to Britain and his family.

From that time on, Patrick dedicated his life to God, eventually receiving Holy Orders. His life was now a continual quest for holiness and doing God's will.

While Patrick was at prayer one night, he heard voices calling to him. An angel appeared to him with the message that the people of Ireland were asking for him to return to their country ... to walk among them once more ... this time, not as a captive, but as one sent by God. Patrick saw God's purpose in all that had gone on before, and immediately chose to return to Ireland. He was made bishop and was sent there to preach the Word of Christ.

In the early days, Patrick was in constant danger of persecution, but the fire that God had placed in his heart kindled throughout all of Ireland, and Patrick came to be regarded as an angel among men.

Now a saint, Patrick stands as a symbol of the Irish ... of the special love of God that is theirs ... of the unique destiny they claim ... of the beloved place they will always have in God's heart.
